

Little Minion Pattern

Abbreviations:

MR - Magic Ring
Inc - Increase
SC - Single Crochet
Sl St - Slip Stitch

Body (yellow)

MR 6
R1: 6x Inc (12)
R2: *1 SC, 1 Inc* x6 (18)
R3: *2 SC, 1 Inc* x6 (24)
R4: *3 SC, 1 Inc* x6 (30)
R5-18: 30 SC, Sl St

Arms (make 2)

MR 6 (black)
R1: 6 SC
R2: change colour to yellow, back loops only 6 SC
SC 6 to 8 rounds, depending on how long you want the arms, Sl St

Legs (make 2)

MR 8 (black)
R1: 8 SC
R2: change colour to blue, 8 SC
R3: 8 SC, Sl St

Pants (blue)

MR 6
R1: 6x Inc (12)
R2: *1 SC, 1 Inc* x6 (18)
R3: *2 SC, 1 Inc* x6 (24)
R4: *3 SC, 1 Inc* x6 (30)
R5-7: 30 SC
chain 1, turn
SC 7, chain 1, turn
SC 7, chain 1, turn
SC 7, chain 11, snip thread, leaving a short tail

count 7 stitches from the front flap, ch 1
SC 9, chain 1, turn
SC 9, chain 1, turn
SC 9, chain 11, snip thread, leaving a short tail
Use the tails to sew the straps onto the flaps.

Stuff the body. While sewing the pants in place keep stuffing for desired firmness.
Use the tails of the arms and legs as stuffing, respectively. Attach to body.
For the eye, cut out a circle of felt. With the grey/silver yarn chain until it fits snugly around that circle, slip stitch the last stitch. 8 cm of black yarn will make the goggle strap.
Glue the eye onto body, making sure all yarn ends are hidden under it. Using white paint, smooth down the felt. Paint iris and pupil, finish with clear coat. Create desired hair style with black sewing thread and finish the little minion with a painted or embroidered mouth.
If you attach a strap to the head before assembling, your little minion can accompany you as a charm! :)
