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# WILD QUAIL GOLF COMMITTEE

The Wild Quail Golf Committee held their monthly meeting on Friday May 3rd 2019 at 5 PM. The following agenda items were reviewed/decided upon

## Golfing News

- The golf Committee welcomes Mike Marshall to the Committee
- The Pro shop has purchased a software package that will allow for better tracking of tee times along with improving advanced communication to our members through their smartphones on information including:
  - Who's playing and when
  - Outings, course closings & tee time availability
  - Course restrictions for the day such as "cart path only"
- By printing time, our season opening tournament (The Gonzalez) will have been played (May 11th). This and other club tournaments will be well advertised ahead of time with the formats of play included. Come out, meet some new members and enjoy some friendly competition this tournament season.
- The May 3rd demo day was successful and a Calloway demo day is being planned for June 1st
- The Committee has approved the purchase of a club washer that will be located on the practice range
- The Committee opened discussion on the potential need for additional ball washers. If this is a significant request, we ask membership to let a Committee member know where desired location(s) should be.
- The Golf Association of Philadelphia (GAP) team matches are underway – both of our Wild Quail teams are making another strong showing and experiencing play at some well know venues.

## Comments from our Superintendent:

I am happy to see our hard work is paying off and the fairways are filling in. As the plants mature and we enter the growing season the fairways will become denser. Unfortunately for now when we have a significant rainfall we will be cart paths only in order to protect the new seedlings. The greens are filling in and will start to speed up now that we are entering the growing season. We had a week of frost when we were aerifying which slowed the recovery of greens. I would like the members help in making everyone aware that bunker rakes should be all the way in the bunkers as many have been left out. This will help with speeding up the rate at which we mow the rough around the greens.

## Other items to know:

- The upper level grass area on the practice range will be open for use on weekends with the lower grass tier being used for practice during member tournaments
- Pre-emergent and broadleaf applications have been applied.
- A significant amount of unrepaired divots continue to scar our fairways. Please help manage the repairs:
  - Roots intact – Gather & replace
  - All others – Fill & level with sand
- We will also make a process change to accelerate the divot repair. Starting Saturday May 11th, and every Saturday during the season, ten gallons of a seed and seed mix will be available for sand bottles. Please make sure the bottles on your cart have this mix in them and bring them back empty (also refills)
- The dead tree on the 15th hole will be removed

## Safety

- Sizeable holes were identified in the following locations and will be addressed:
  - The area between the #6 & #9 fairways short of the pond
  - In the geech area between #10 & #11
  - Right side of # 16 fairway

We encourage our members to share their ideas with us and thank them for their continued support & care of the golf course
